Ludwig Boltzmann Institute for Network Medicine, Vienna

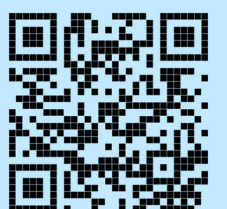
Dr. Guthrie is an expert in the protein interactome. She pioneered network-based classification of rare immune disorders, revealing how protein interactions shape biological function and disease.
